

Recommended Courses for New Students

Full time registration ranges from 9-12 credits. Registering for more than 12 credits is not recommended. Below are lists of courses for each program that are in priority order. Students should register for the courses in this order. If courses need to be dropped, follow the reverse order. For example, for MPH-EOHS, the first course to register for would be EOHS 610 followed by EOHS 620, etc. If a student registers for 4 courses and later needs to drop a course, then the course to drop should be EPID 610.
