Dear Dr. Gaba:

This letter is to advise you of the action taken by the Accreditation Council for Education in Nutrition and Dietetics (ACEND®) board regarding the proposed Dietetic Internship (DI) at City University of New York. During its May 8, 2017 meeting, the ACEND board voted to grant Candidacy for Accreditation to your program. Candidacy for Accreditation is granted for a non-degree DI Program enrolling 10 on-site and 20 remote full-time interns annually. The program will have a Public Health Nutrition concentration.

The decision was based on a peer review of the self-study report, the site visit report and your program's response to the site visit report. ACEND recognizes your program's compliance with the Accreditation Standards and encourages you to continue your efforts in providing quality dietetics education. Interns accepted as of this date, and those in succeeding classes, will be eligible, upon satisfactory completion of the program, to write the Commission on Dietetic Registration's Registration Examination for Dietitians.

A site-visit for full accreditation will be scheduled after two classes have graduated and written the Registration Examination for Dietitian Nutritionists, but no later than **May 31 2020**. Please notify ACEND staff in writing when the second class is enrolled to begin the site-visit scheduling process. A self-study report for full accreditation addressing the Accreditation Standards in effect at that time must be submitted to ACEND for review prior to the site-visit. Because Candidacy for Accreditation cannot extend more than four years, the Candidacy for Accreditation term will end on **May 8, 2021**.

Computer matching is mandatory for all Dietetic Internship appointments. Contact an ACEND staff member with any questions you may have regarding the computer matching process. In addition, all programs are required to pay an annual accreditation fee. To obtain the prorated annual accreditation fee invoice, click <u>ACEND Fee Invoice</u>. Payment is due no later than **July 7, 2017.** If the payment is not received by the due date a late fee will apply.

Ordinarily, major program changes other than program director or administrative structure changes will not be accepted from or approved for programs with Candidacy for Accreditation status. Guidelines for reporting major changes are on the Accreditation Community of the ACEND portal which can be accessed at education.webauthor.com.
