PURPOSE

Every spring, CUNY Graduate School of Public Health and Health Policy (CUNY SPH) conducts a survey of alumni from the first year following graduation. The survey asks alumni to evaluate their experiences at CUNY SPH and to report professional and educational achievements since graduation. Survey insights are used to plan and strengthen curriculum and support services.

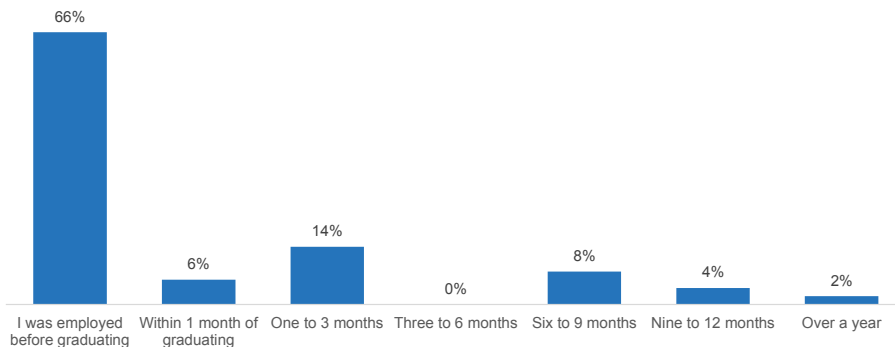
In Spring 2019, MPH, MS, and DPH alumni who graduated in 2017—2018 received an invitation with a link to an online survey. Of the 134 who were contacted, 56 alumni responded to the survey, yielding a 42% response rate.

Among employed alumni, here are the responses to: "How long did it take you to find employment following graduation?"



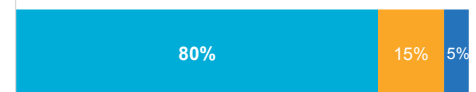
Alumni Job Titles



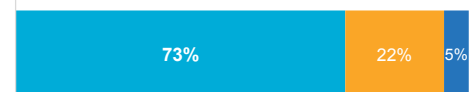
Career Preparation
