

# Current Student Survey

## Fall 2019

### PURPOSE

Every Fall semester, CUNY Graduate School of Public Health and Health Policy (CUNY SPH) administers the Current Student Survey to gather data on student experiences to better understand their needs, as well as strengthen CUNY SPH's programs and services.

729 degree-seeking students received an invitation on October 24, 2019. 375 students responded to the survey, yielding a 51% response rate.

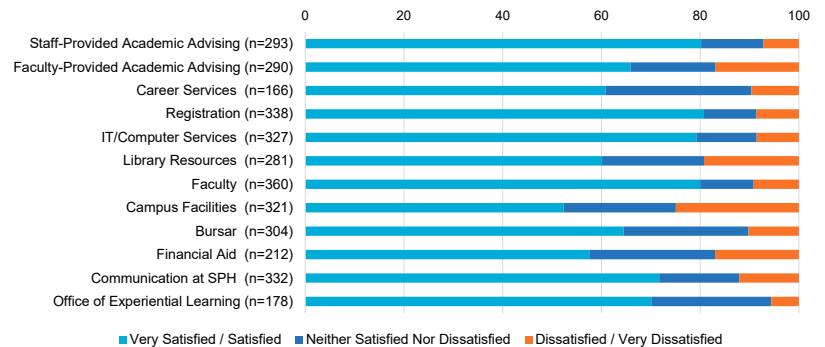

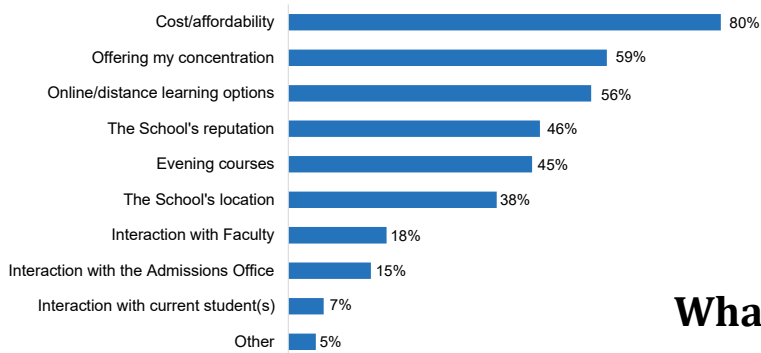
### Level of Satisfaction with Services

### Why Students Enroll At CUNY SPH

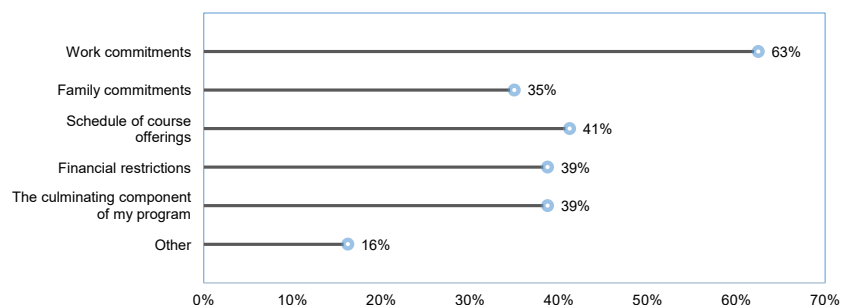
For students completing the survey, here are the share who cited each of these reasons as a factor influencing their decision to enroll
