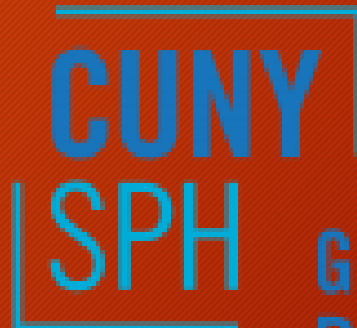

*The employee/student is responsible to notify Public Safety of any changes to the order of protection.*




