PURPOSE

Every spring, CUNY Graduate School of Public Health and Health Policy (CUNY SPH) conducts a survey of alumni from the first year following graduation. The survey asks alumni to evaluate their experiences at CUNY SPH and to report professional and educational achievements since graduation. Survey insights are used to plan and strengthen curriculum and support services.

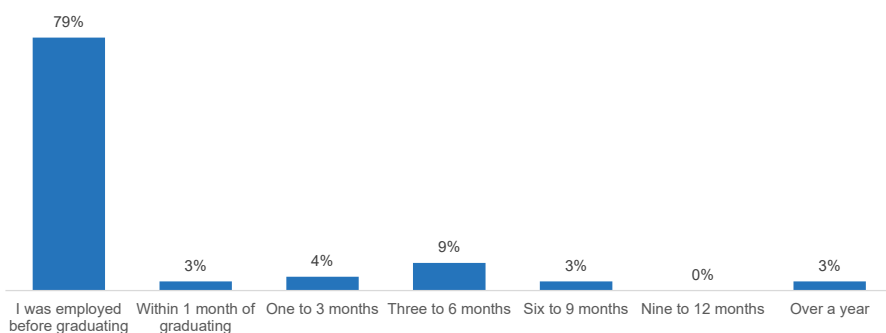
In Spring 2024, master's and doctoral alumni from the class of 2022-23 received an invitation to an online survey. Follow-up calls were made to boost participation. Out of the 281 alumni contacted, 148 responded, resulting in a 53% response rate.
