



The mission of CUNY Graduate School of Public Health and Health Policy (CUNY SPH) is to promote and sustain healthier populations in New York City and around the world. As part of this mission, CUNY SPH encourages its community to walk and utilize public transit to reduce road vehicle congestion. In compliance with the building policy of CRG Management at 55 West 125 Street, New York, NY 10027, battery powered micromobility devices are prohibited inside the building. This policy does not apply to adaptive mobility devices such as electric wheelchairs or electric walkers.

Micromobility devices includes but not limited to electric bicycles, electric scooters, hoverboards, electric skateboards, electric unicycles, and electric mopeds. The battery and electronics inside micromobility devices can be defective and overheat, creating a fire, or explosion.¹ Fire extinguishers do not work on lithium-ion batteries fires.² These devices are prohibited on-campus and entry will be denied for persons with these devices.
